National Federation of Plus Areas 2016 Audit Report

This was a tricky audit given the change in National Finance Officer and what seems to have been a less than perfect handover.

In particular there are some issues I have been unable to get to the bottom of. The balance of the SADY bank account, and what National's stake is in that money, I have not been able to confirm. For the purpose of this audit I have therefore assumed that the position is the same as last year.

Another complicating factor is that the National AGM was run through the National bank account so there was no identified cost for National Officers' attendance. The event made a £215 loss but National had a cost avoided, which in 2015 was £630.

Clarification is needed regarding who are signatories to the SADY and Spring holiday bank accounts.

One matter of concern is the fact that there was no National levy paid in 2016 by East Anglia Area and Southern Area.

I received the figures needed for this audit rather later than in previous years, no doubt due in part to having a new NFO who was reliant on others providing some of the necessary information.

The total interest of Member Areas has increased by £785.12 to £21,105.78 in 2016.

This can be primarily attributed to significantly lower levels of expenditure than in previous years.
